1. Chair Appointment

It was unanimously agreed that Cllr Chris Parker would Chair the meeting on this occasion.

2. Declarations of Interests

3. Minutes

It was unanimously agreed to accept the minutes of the last meeting held on 28th November 2019.

4. Have your say

A discussion was had regarding the types of spend allowable for Community Infrastructure Levy monies, followed by a brief description of items already on the Council 123 List, which comprises of ideas from members and co-optees.

5. Planters

Recommended

The Acting Clerk to obtain styles, sizes and quoted for troughs to place on the Welcome to Llanharan signs and planters for the bottom of Meadow Rise, the entrance to Dyffryn Crescent and next to the bench at William Street.

6. Grove Terrace Memorial Garden

A discussion took place regarding sustainable surfaces to replace the currently broken area. Rob James volunteered to draw up a sketch to include, bollards, planters and trees.

The Acting Clerk suggested using a wildflower starter pack she has applied for from Keep Wales Tidy to plant around the edges and the round garden area.

Recommended

Use wild-flower starter pack to enhance the area.

Action

Rob James to provide a plan and ideas regarding surfacing and landscaping.

8. Christmas Motifs

Following a recent 'Christmas Light' survey, whereby members of the public had the opportunity to suggest ideas for improving the community light display, a discussion took place regarding locations for the extra 35 motifs agreed by Council.

Action

- a. Cllr Roger Turner to contact RCT to see if the lampposts between Trenos Place and the film studios can be upgraded to support Christmas motifs.
- b. Cllr Roger Turner to obtain prices for the upgrade of the electrics on 2 lampposts between Terrys Way and Llanharan Stores.

The Chair asked the Committee to consider the replacement of the following bus shelters:

- a. Outside Mid Glam construction replace the current full bus stop with a cantilever style.
- a. Mountain Hare Pub further investigations to be carried out.
