



Street cleaning is very poor in southill street festive decorations are quite sparse in southill st what bus shelter im not on facebook hardly enough parking if there are 3 cars per house

i dont feel safe after dark(1 mentions)

Over 60s lunch score 10 (1 mentions)

The litter is disgusting (1 mentions)

Firework display is too noisy (1 mentions)

Not enough work done by councillors (1 mentions)

Make councillors work for their pay (1 mentions)

Over 60s lunches a big winner thank you please do more for your pensioners (1 mentions)

Thank you please do your best for all in 2025 community councillors poorly advertised (1 mentions)

Include brynna in the questions food bank should be means tested not enough noticeboards in village community councillors poorly advertised (1 mentions)

Get homeowners to cut their hedges overhanging the pavements if not you cut it and bill them (1 mentions)

Christmas lights opposite the green car parking needs sorting by top shop in southall st its an accident waiting to happen (1 mentions)

Christmas lights on main street opposite the green brynna and yes there are suitable lampposts where is the council office (1 mentions)

Dr surgery in brynna or prescription dropoff traffic needs to be sorted many speeding over 20mph where can you get clearfood refuse bags (1 mentions)

Would like to know if the bypass is going through and when traffic is horrendous through the village (1 mentions)

Bus shelters need to be more enclosed at the sides (1 mentions)

Over 60s lunches score 6 (1 mentions)

More street cleaning (1 mentions)

More benches between llanharan and brynna (1 mentions)

The council office is not manned enough (2 mentions)

I think cycle paths could be incorporated into the area around llanharan welfare hall more litter bins and dog poo bins would be welcomed the parks are well maintained not on facebook so not always aware of local events (1 mentions)

You need a path from terry witts area to railway station alongside train track this will reduce people walking on main road (1 mentions)

New footpaths should be adopted in around new housing estates to take people off the main road too many festive and flower displays nature walks could be improved for everyone to access (1 mentions)

More awareness needed about services and events in llanharan more funding to develop lcdp a much needed facility parking is atrocious especially around schools school parking is terrible and dangerous nowehere near enough parking facilities at llanharan primary and parking for dolau school appears to be at bryncae streets causing chaos havent noticed any flower displays sorry not sure of council office location paths in nature walks get waterlogged not enough advertising of local events

havent seen any commuity police lately (1 mentions)

It would be extremely advantageous if we were afforded a regular litter picker with the recent removal of the wheelie bins there has been a noticeable rise in litter on our streets (1 mentions)

Give more to old age (1 mentions)

where are noticeboards located

More pedestrian crossings on bridgend road (1 mentions)

Better road crossing stop large lorries going through bridgend road (1 mentions)

The village has never looked so nasty and full of weeds streets are very rarely swept needs someone to keep it clean say two days a week (1 mentions)

Refurbish steps from bridgend road to park view council office could be open more often

still waiting for the leaflet about the nature walks council phone goes to voicemail too often nothing on website about events noticeboards not always up to date neil mcandrew (1 mentions)

Dont think the community councillors represent the area just seem to be concerned about bridle paths and not the community in general play areas getting fenced off bus shelters full of drug users where are the nature walks and noticeboards (1 mentions)

Not enough bus shelters benches (1 mentions)

More tree cutting in top of meadow rise grass pick up on pitch allan (1 mentions)

Brynna woods i am informed of local events via facebook (1 mentions)

Score 6 for over 60s lunches (1 mentions)

More benches in park areas (1 mentions)

At times i feel unsafe people selling drugs from cars (1 mentions)

Mrs l m hease not enough bus shelters benches (1 mentions)

I like the foodbank if it is needed need new skatepark (1 mentions)

Flower displays to entry of bryncae estate to near road obstructing view to oncoming traffic from pencoed square bring back big wheelies as new black bag not fit for health issues rubbish in street from broken bag skatepark does not apply to bryncae park (1 mentions)

Public toilet caf facilities cannot read notice boards as visually impaired (1 mentions)

Speed control not policed enough too many heavily loaded lorries running in a small narrow heavily parked village (1 mentions)

No bus stops or post boxes up enterprise way need buses to come up and benches to sit on none up toward lonydd glas too much building work around nature walks (1 mentions)

More parking for the elderly (1 mentions)

More of them bus shelters benches (1 mentions)

We have lost too many nature walks to houses i dont feel safe when trying to cross the road (1 mentions)

Refuse collection is excellent more buses please (1 mentions)

Not happy with black bag system causing rubbish caused by animals everywhere nor collection only every 3 weeks (1 mentions)

Please bring back the wheelie bins or extra black bags for everyone (1 mentions)

Not happy about wheelie bins being done away with a lot of rubbish now in the road (1 mentions)

Problems with refuse collections extra black bags needed (1 mentions)

Not more houses new school new doctors shops pavements and drop kerbs need to be looked into before fireworks flower arranging bypass when

heavy goods vehicles through llanharan (1 mentions)

Pavement towards the coop in need of widening maintenance trip hazard (1 mentions)

Pavement towards coop needs widening and repairing always full of puddles hazard for oaps (1 mentions)

Drop pavements need to be addressed please also by pass would be good to many heavy goods vehicles as this i understand is a learner driver area (1 mentions)

Congratulations on a job well done the animals hate the fireworks i dont always feel safe some children have been victimised and had things thrown at them (1 mentions)

Exercising equipment in the park for the over 60s food bank gives to people who dont need it dont know where the council office is i dont feel safe at night (1 mentions)

Over 60s lunches 5 plus more exercise equipment for 60 (1 mentions)

C edwards (1 mentions)

Good job being done well done where is the council office i do not feel safe at night (1 mentions)

Update some parks (1 mentions)

firework display hate it animals suffer a be proud of your area committee

brynnas doggy litter bag scheme is good brynna allotments dreadful im not on facebook need more litter picking (1 mentions)

Need community police (1 mentions)

Potholes in roads need doing urgently (1 mentions)

I do not like the brynna allotments (1 mentions)

4g pitch better christmas tree (1 mentions)

Need more for the older children a covered area near skate park etc would be great you should charge a fee for the fireworks display (1 mentions)

Need more facilities for children to enjoy sport pontyclun has got y pant 4g llanharan need a 4g pitch (1 mentions)

4g pitch would be good (1 mentions)

Would like a christmas tree like llanharry really effective and would be a positive addition to the village four g pitch for activities for local groups in llanharan (1 mentions)

Didnt notice any flower displays skate park is good for youth dont know where the council office and noticeboards are not aware of full council services (1 mentions)

Park view hope lane behind bridgend road always litter flytip more silent fireworks food bank not open long enough (1 mentions)

Need more street cleaning dont do my street (1 mentions)

1 we really do not need further housing in around llanharan gp surgeries are over stretched without more patients arriving 2 road structure inadequate to take more vehicles (1 mentions)

The hedges are poorly managed by my property the access to my garage at the end of the lane behind brook terrace joining hillside avenue is awful and im unable to drive my car to my garage for fear of my car getting damaged by the overgrown hedges and moy children play in that lane i would also like to see proper fencing around the play area adjacent to harold street park the dog fouling mess in there is horrendous and my son plays football in there the sign clearly states no dogs yet the fencing is poor so dogs run in there to do their business (1 mentions)

Decent walk to talbot green paths are two narrow and full ruts (1 mentions)

More communication via local hubs to provide updates lcc specific like the psm garden project but also rctbc like the bypass or 20mph review (1 mentions)

You're doing a great job i cant think of anything else (1 mentions)

Bring back the summer fete from days long gone it brought people together and was great fun (1 mentions)

More help for after school clubs in schools (1 mentions)

Be good if the embankment in front of cottages by brooklands terrace cottages llanharry tidied up as a terrible mess and muddy due to blocked drains and leaves embankment is all brambles and overgrown (1 mentions)

When planning christmas lights bunting etc need to consider the removal as well and factor this planning into the timescales

also please clean the signs in the village area covered by the council as they really are awful (1 mentions)

Indoor sports facilities cycle paths are much needed in the area (1 mentions)

Please stop the fireworks its terrifying for animals and a huge waste of money (1 mentions)

Spend the money for xmas lights on fixing potholes (1 mentions)

Pressure on rct regards pothole repairs and parking wardens to stop the parking of cars on pavements which is a hazard for the elderly and young mums ps what is the pantry (1 mentions)

More dog poo bins placed in side streets etc there are lots of areas where dog walkers go and are either throwing their bags on the floor or not picking it up (1 mentions)

Ally off bridgend road between numbers 36 and 38 never clean bin collection between the same street and park view poor (1 mentions)

I dont know what the pantry is but i had to give an answer so i just opted for 3 (1 mentions)

Too many illegal parking (1 mentions)

More information and updates on the things mentioned here would go towards improving the score the things i know about are scored highly (1 mentions)

Ice treatment of walkways especially the downslopes very dangerous when walking to drop off children to school (1 mentions)

Maintain pavements and walkways to school flower displays are lovely but please ensure that they do not block the view of the road pulling out of the estate opposite kj roofing bryncae is dangerous as the flower pot is too far forwards obstructing the view of the road (1 mentions)

Whilst we appreciate the free fireworks display i would think the money be better spent elsewhere maybe a small fee to enter (1 mentions)

So much dog poo on our streets (1 mentions)

Dog poo there are far too many inconsiderate dog owners who dont clean up after their animals usually in the same spots along the pavements targeted enforcement with the council or cctv to help catch offenders would be great (1 mentions)

The play area at bryncae community centre the amount of dog mess around (1 mentions)

A covered and lit up areas for teens across the villages would be welcome for example bandstandsat some of parks or council owned areas etc there is very little covered spaces for fhem when they are out and about with friends in poor weather if you inckude them in the design and set up my guess is you will get respectful beviour once if they feel some form of ownership of these spaces fireworks whilst a lovely thought would rather it were a paid event as it is open to residents outside of our community and money is better spent elsewhere (1 mentions)

Bryncae community centre park area

explanation of what is happening to the fenced off area of bryncae community centre park is it now a private area or will it be reopen to the public once completed when will work be finished (1 mentions)

More dog poo bins (1 mentions)

I feel llanharan is always kept to an excellent standard i have no issues with anything other than speeding cars through the village around childrens parks and achool bus stops (1 mentions)

Dog waste bins emptied more often, christmas lights or tree at the entrance to parc bryn derwen (1 mentions)

More frequent maintenance to footpaths linking housing estates to enable children to move around the village without the need to go on the main road eg between parc bryn derwen and the football field opencast

a path between parc bryn derwen and fords dol y coed would also be very beneficial to the many parents children carers teenagers who travel on foot or by bikescooter

it would be good to focus on the essentials rather than the nice to haves ie fireworks and summer flowers although i do love the fireworks and they are brilliant

Proactive dog mess reducing initiative, getting children in the community more involved in making it a better please, recognition and reward and or getting the community k9re aware and involved with the bio diversity of their community nature plants importance of preservation through events community walks to get people more active or the lonely out in a safe group perhaps a cuppa and biscuit after (1 mentions)

Personally i would like to see more investment in outdoor playing areas for children the park in llanharan is ok but there are very few things for younger children to play with i have 2 daughters 5 2 and we find it hard spending more than 20 minutes there due to the lack of equipment in the play park considering the area is already there and more and more housing is being built with younger families moving in it would draw more people out of their homes and spend time in their local communities and likely increase foot fall in all of the small businesses in the local area (1 mentions)

The streets especially near our home on bridgend road near hafan roofing are poorly maintained the litter and fly tipping is getting worse (1 mentions)

There is a lot of dog mess around the streets in bryncae the school run is getting to be like an obstacle course trying to get the kids to dodge the poo if some form of regular clean up could be introduced that would be great plus something to deter people from leaving their dog mess on the street maybe better signage around the place to highlight fines etc (1 mentions)

Tree trimming (1 mentions)

Measures to improve community spaces and sense of community are great for peoples health wellbeing and can foster closer better functioning communities that support each other and lead to less reliance on outside hell (1 mentions)

A park beside bryncae community centre (1 mentions)

Theres a big flower box pallet planter on the corner of dyffryn crescent which makes pulling out of the junction a nightmare as you cant see oncoming traffic the street lights between trenos gardens and the studios need to be completed pressure should be put on the council or persimmon for this as its unsafe and makes people feel cut off from the rest of the village in the winter also clamping down on people parking on verges and double yellows on the school run thanks very much (1 mentions)

Some patches need some maintenance (1 mentions)

Can we not waste our money on decorations and flowers keeping the parks for kids clean and broken fences and family communal areas should be a priority fix the things that matter most for the people who live here (1 mentions)

I believe you all do a great job in difficult circumstances and an ever decreasing budget it must be very difficult to juggle priorities and please everyone but llanharan is a great place to live thank you (1 mentions)

Address the dog poo situation (1 mentions)

Poo bins up by the open cast for dog walkers to put their poo bags to discourage dumping them on the ground (1 mentions)

Building a sense of community across our villages are essential to supporting the wider community for me access to parks and clean pavements pathways are a great start to building that sense of pride is there anyway we could ask the local schools to contribute in a litter picking schedule to clear and help maintain our local parks i think itll help our young children and young adults to develop a sense of pride collaboration community and

responsibility which can be fostered over the long term another suggestion what about a games afternoon with young adults and retired folks playing together and learning things from one another thats all i can think of for now (1 mentions)

The street cleaning is virtually non existent is appreciate the public are to mainly blame for the rubbish the amount of rubbish around and weeds its making the village look scruffy and dirty

the brambles are overgrown in certain places and during the summer the nettles outside dolau are constantly stinging adults and children alike the skate park is great but doesnt service the lower end of the llanharan the children and teenagers need something else other than benches to sit on the funding for llanharan drop in centre for the drop in centre was cut as they couldnt run a full time playscheme or youth club during the holidays this is vital resource for children in our community for their social interaction and gives them something to do other than sitting at home or causing problems in the village (1 mentions)

Regular monitoring of persistent pavement parkers its an epidemic especially around dolau school and surrounding streets (1 mentions)

Funding for our local community sports fields are well below expectations i appreciate some are council adopted or owned by external parties however i do feel more needs to be done to protect our children when it comes to playing sports in the area the standard of our pitches namely grass drainage lighting across brynna llanharan is below my expectations as a keen volunteer at both local clubs i believe more can be done to protect this for the future of welsh sport thank you (1 mentions)

Keep funding for after school clubs in schools (1 mentions)

more family eventsfetes etc charge for entry at the firework display more advertising im on all the hubs and never see anything advertised (1 mentions)

Path maintenance

some of the paths walkways are very uneven have potholes i have 3 young children find some of the paths difficult to push a buggy on for the kids to ride their scooters balance bikes on (1 mentions)

Enforce fines for dog fouling (1 mentions)

Safer crossings in brynna especially near leyshons (1 mentions)

It would be nice to have a firework display in brynna

i dont live in llanharan so cant comment on allotments

there are allotments in brynna which are mostly well maintained although burning of waste is a problem at all hours of day and night (1 mentions)

Brynna park by community centre the muck in the park (1 mentions)

Planting of wild flower areas trees etc

consideration of covered play areas to provide outdoor play opportunities in poor weather although im not sure how feasible this would be (1 mentions)

Bins we need more public bins as some have been destroyed and not replaced such as church view brynna (1 mentions)

Sustainable transport campaign for a safe cycle path from llanharan to talbot green

parent and baby free or very low cost donation parent and baby groups (1 mentions)

Cleaning of pavements on william street more dog mess visible (1 mentions)

Wraparound school care 5 days a week (1 mentions)

Communicate relevant info here and on community hubs eg bypass rct yes but with a strong community interest (1 mentions)

When there is a lcc election or by election and the result has been confirmed can you please publish the results on the website its hard work getting any information like that im not even sure who my councillors for my area are (1 mentions).

Ensure people doing community service do it (1 mentions)

Street cleaning regularly particularly rear of bridgend road lane entrance to park view lane

a pelican crossing is much needed on bridgend road by drop in centre and bus stops

grit bins in new estate michaels grove

lighting in co op car park liasing with private owner

signage to brynna woods and allotments on side of school better communication of information and events and upcoming information on local council facebook page (1 mentions)

Street cleaning should be rct (1 mentions)

Fix the floodlights on the welfare field so that they are not left on constantly (1 mentions)

Dr surgery in llanharan is top priority why waste money on fireworks when the money can be put towards the drs we have nothing in the village and it is like a ghost town yet rates are rising never a truer sentence than llanharan the forgotten village (1 mentions)

Theres nothing for children over 10 to do the drop in centre is not used by 95 of these villages and has a poor rep so will not be used the skate park again for younger kids this problem will only get worse as the young kids now in new estates will grow causing vandalism for no reason other than just boredom (1 mentions)

Support local charities like lcdp to support childcare youth playwork cafe community support like happy days group etc (1 mentions)
