Then total cost for the event was £7,069.32

Note that in the past the method of pricing the event has been for LCDP to give an estimate of cost items (with a fixed LCDP fee), for LCDP to make all necessary arrangements and for The Council to pay those costs directly or for LCDP to invoice us all in one. This can lead to a small variance in actual costs versus estimate. In 2021 the actual cost was cheaper than the estimate as LCDP were able to make some savings.

LCDP have trained and competent staff and the appropriate licences. They also carry out the event risk assessments and arrange the detail for the event licences etc...

The Community Council's only involvement n the operational aspects of the event last year were in respect of the co-ordination of marketing and ticketing arrangements and the submission of the temporary event licence.

There is £7425 set aside in the 2022/23 budget for a fireworks display.

Event provider.
Scope of quote (If quotes required).
Scope of work required outside of any quote.
Venue.
Resources.

Appendix 7

2022 Festive lights

'The Festivelighting Company' have given a quotation for a 3 year fixed contract for the hire of motifs. This is based on a valuation of £400 per motif. See Appendix 7c.

The cost of the quotation can be reduced by reducing the value of each motif (There are motifs over a range of values available). This exercise has been carried out in theory - See Appendix 7d.

The Clerk estimates that given the 2022/23 budget of £26,000 for Christmas lights and trees, and an estimated cost of £17,000 for erection and taking down of the same (also includes taking down summer hanging baskets) and an estimated cost of £1500 for Christmas trees and £3000 for tree lights and ancillaries then a 3 year fixed contract of a maximum of £4000 per annum for 3 years would be acceptable in order to meet the 2022/23 budget commitment.

It is proposed that a working group be formed with a limited number of members to select from the stock catalogue the individual motifs and ancillary items to be hired for the community and where to place each motif. Appendix 7d can be used as a starting point. The terms of reference for the working group to be ensure that adequate numbers of motifs are hired to ensure at least like for like motif coverage as 2021 with a maximum cost of £6500 per annum.

It is proposed that the working group make recommendations to the Audit Committee which shall be given delegated authority to place orders only to the value of £6500 with a contingency of 10%

Note that the supplier recommends that stock items are chosen in good time.

Appendix 8

Community Engagement Working group

The previous Community Engagement Committee was changed to a working group in 2021. The group has yet to meet since the start of the pandemic.

The previous Terms of reference for the Committee were:

All local residents are welcome to attend the community engagement committee where you will have the opportunity at the beginning of each meeting to discuss your ideas or ask questions of the council during the half hour 'Have your say' session. Ideas and questions submitted in advance will have discussion priority.

This is a key strategic committee used to help set the overall direction of the Council. Responsible for communicating and consulting with local residents and all other relevant stakeholders to deliver better services and projects.

This committee meets every two months and is made up of 6 councillors and can coopt up-to 6 individuals from local community. The committee can create working groups for developing and researching activities and projects.

This committee's responsibilities include co-ordinating annual Christmas lights and the bi-annual flowering baskets.

Council is invited to decide which members will sit on the working group and any adjustments to the Terms of reference that may be necessary/desirable outside of those that will be necessary to alter the terms from that of a committee to a working group.

Scope

A 'hybrid meeting' is a meeting where some people opt to attend a venue in person (face to face) whilst some opt to attend the same meeting virtually.

The purpose of this paper is to update Councillors on the situation regarding the method of conducting Council meetings following queries from several Councillors.

Councillors may consider making resolutions to indicate whether a move to hybrid meetings is desirable at this time, to set a budget for and to delegate authority to purchase such equipment as is deemed necessary to facilitate hybrid meetings and to decide upon a venue.

The Act

The Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 states:

47Attendance at local authority meetings

- (1)A local authority must make and publish arrangements for the purpose of ensuring that local authority meetings are able to be held by means of any equipment or other facility which—
- (a) enables persons who are not in the same place to attend the meetings, and
- (b) satisfies the conditions in subsection (2).
- (2) The conditions are that the equipment or other facility enables persons—
-to speak to and be heard by each other (whether or not the equipment or facility enables those persons to see and be seen by each other).
 - Officer's note. In this instance 'Local authority' includes Community Councils. All committees and sub-committees are included.

Officer's notes

- The current method of continuing to conduct meetings purely remotely is acceptable.
- If there is a desire to return to face-to-face meetings, the Council must retain the facility to attend remotely for those who wish to do so.
- Purely face to face meetings with no ability for Councillors or members of the public to attend remotely is unlawful.

Venue

Points of note:

 A permanent venue could be selected where suitable equipment could be set up permanently or semi-permanently to ensure a consistent quality of meeting for those attending and for maintaining the quality of interactions between remote and in person attendees.

- This would also help ensure there was adequate space to accommodate members of the public when necessary and would ensure the acoustics of the venue were suitable for hybrid meetings using the equipment purchased.
- A block booking of a suitable venue could be made for full council meetings (where numbers are greatest, and members of the public are most likely to attend).
- Full Council could be trialled as a hybrid meeting and if successful and/or practical could be rolled out to Committees at a later date.
- If it is not possible to secure a venue for any meeting, then that meeting can be held solely as a virtual meeting.
- It is essential that any potential venue has a reliable, high-capacity internet and wi-fi capability. Note: It may be necessary to upgrade an existing capability at a chosen venue.

Risk assessment

A risk assessment including suitable control measures to manage the risks posed by Covid19 could be required for those aspects of any meeting to be held face to face. The Clerk would produce a draft risk assessment depending on the venue selected.

Equipment

Council should consider how it envisages meetings looking in the future.

Factors to consider when selecting equipment:

- Should attendees be able to see each other as well as hear each other?
- The size of the meeting space required given the potential number of attendees both virtually and face to face.

- The type of equipment given the number of attendees, the physical space and the acoustic characteristics of the venue.
- The quality and likely longevity of equipment v initial capital cost.
- The budget that Council is prepared to commit to the equipment.
- The quality of the engagement and experience provided to a person attending remotely.

Proposal

Venue

That Llanharan OAP hall be trialled as a venue. Should the trial be successful that the Council block books each third Thursday of the month for 2 hours per meeting at a cost of £20 per meeting (£10/hour).

That following 3 successful hybrid full council meetings, the council consider moving Committee meetings to hybrid.

The hall is adequate in size to meet current and future needs and to accommodate a reasonable number of members of the public should such a need arise. The hall has recently had high speed internet installed.

Parking is available at the venue but is limited.
