2020/53 Appointment of Clerk to the Council/Responsible Financial Officer
The Chair of the Human Resources Committee (Cllr Hopkins) reported that
interviews had been held for the position of Clerk and Responsible Officer to the
Council. The recommendation of the Committee was put to the Council and it was
resolved unanimously that that Ms Catherine Kennedy be appointed as Clerk and
Responsible Financial Officer to Llanharan Community Council. Furthermore, the
Chair of the Human Resources Committee reported that it was the unanimous
resolution of the Committee to recommend to the Council that the other candidate
interviewed for the role answered everything that would be required in the job
description and person specification of the vacant position of Assistant
Clerk/Project Officer. It was felt by the Committee that this person's skills and
experience would complement that of the Clerk very well. It was therefore resolved
unanimously by the Council to authorise the Chair of the Human Resources
Committee to offer the

post of Assistant Clerk/Project Officer to that candidate and - should he accept - that the Council engage him with a probation period of six months.

The business thus concluded, Ms Kennedy was then invited by the Chair of the Council to join the meeting, whereupon she received the congratulations and good wishes of all present.
