Pre-Tender Notice: Christmas Display Erection Contract (2025-2028) Llanharan Community Council – 3-Year Contract Opportunity

To whom it may concern,

Llanharan Community Council is inviting expressions of interest from **qualified electrical contractors** for a **3-year contract (2025-2028)** to erect, maintain, and remove Christmas motifs, lighting, and tree displays.

This is an **exciting opportunity** to secure a multi-year public contract worth in the region of **£35,000 - £45,000** offering financial stability and the chance to expand your portfolio in the public sector.

We actively encourage **small and medium-sized electrical contractors** to participate and are committed to providing guidance on the necessary qualifications.

Why Bid for This Contract?

Scope of Work

The successful contractor will be responsible for:

1. Christmas Lighting & Motifs Installation

- Erecting and removing approximately 91 motifs and string lights onto lampposts.
- **Connecting all lights** to the **existing mains supply**.

2. Christmas Tree Displays

- 46 x 4ft Christmas trees to be installed in wall-mounted brackets above local businesses.
- 14 x 4ft Christmas trees to be installed on 3 community centre buildings in Llanharan, Brynna, and Ynysmaerdy.
- 10 x 16ft Christmas trees to be installed and decorated with 12 light strings per tree.
- Securely connecting all tree lights to the appropriate mains power supply.

3. Additional Decorations

- Fastening two sets of six light strings to the fencing at Dolau School.
- Installing and connecting a **motif display** at Brynnau Primary School.

4. End-of-Season Removal & Storage

- Taking down and **safely storing all decorations** in a mutually agreed location.
- Returning all lighting equipment to us or directly to the lighting provider in good condition.
- Transporting Christmas trees to a **designated recycling point**.

5. Hanging Basket Removal

• Removing summer hanging baskets from lampposts as part of the Christmas light installation.

Qualification & Compliance Requirements

The successful contractor must:

Hold **public liability insurance** appropriate for this type of work.

Be a qualified electrical contractor (Minimum Level 3 Qualification and 18th Edition IEE Wiring Regulations).

Provide a **Risk Assessment & Method Statement (RAMS)** for the work.

The work must comply with:

- ✓ BS7671: 2011 IEE Wiring Regulations (18th Edition)
- ✓ Health and Safety at Work Act 1974
- ✓ Electricity at Work Regulations 1989
- ✓ HSE Working at Height Regulations
- ✓ Traffic Signs Manual Chapter 8
- ✓ ILP Lasers, Festival & Entertainment Lighting Code
- ✓ ERG39 Authorisation & Certification (see details below)

Additional Training & Certification (Available Post-Tender)

To work on RCTCBC lampposts, specific authorisation and training are required. **However**, **we encourage companies without these qualifications to apply** as they can be obtained after securing the contract.

The contractor must have designated personnel who can obtain:

G39 – Highway Electrical Safety Certification (£200, course available across the UK).
MEWP (Cherry Picker) IPAF License (£200, available locally) – unless the contractor hires a MEWP with a qualified operator.

Llanharan Community Council will launch the **formal tender early in 2025** to give contractors time to complete these certifications if needed.
